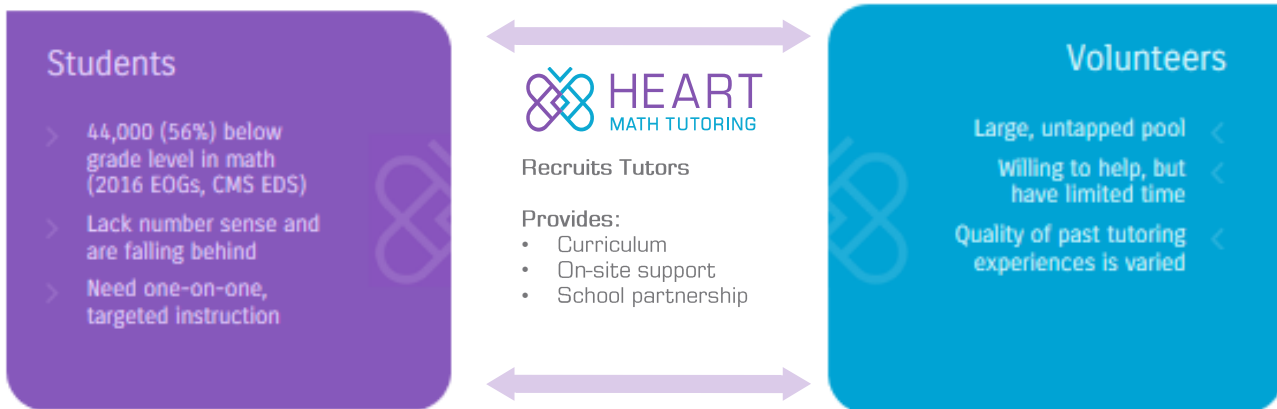


Heart serves as the link between volunteers and elementary students who need help.



Heart's mission is to ensure that all elementary students develop a **strong foundation in math** and **enthusiasm for academics** needed for long-term success, by helping schools use volunteers as tutors.

➔ **Growth in math skills:** 98% of Heart students tutored to date have met program growth targets, showing growth in two or more foundational math concepts. On average, students have grown in over four concept areas.

Curriculum

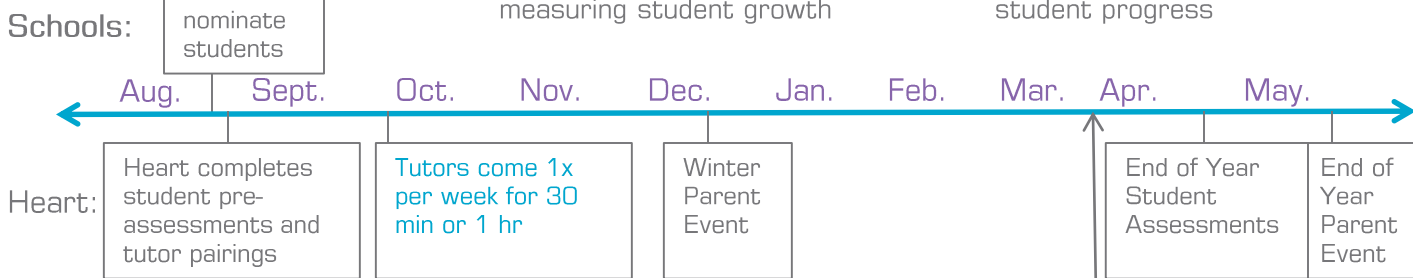
Heart uses a CMS-approved, Common Core-based curriculum designed specifically for volunteer tutors. It includes:

- Hands-on activities
- Clear goals, learning levels
- Instruction targeted to meet each student's specific needs
- Pre- and Post-assessments measuring student growth

On-Site Coordinator

Heart provides an on-site Program Coordinator to each school site. Responsibilities include:

- Training and coordinating volunteers
- Coordinating and completing student assessments
- Communicating with teachers
- Monitoring and supporting student progress

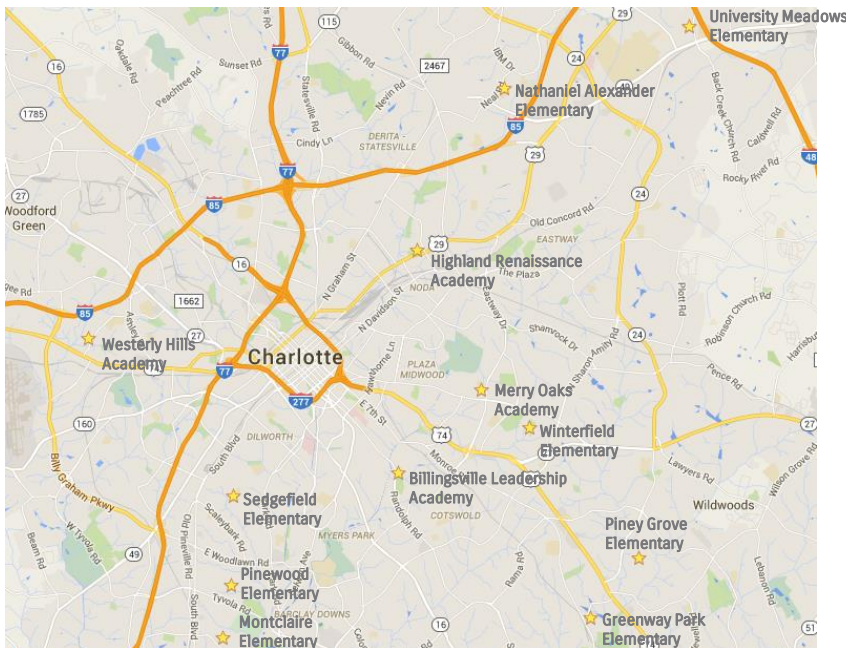
- Tutor-friendly lesson plans, materials
