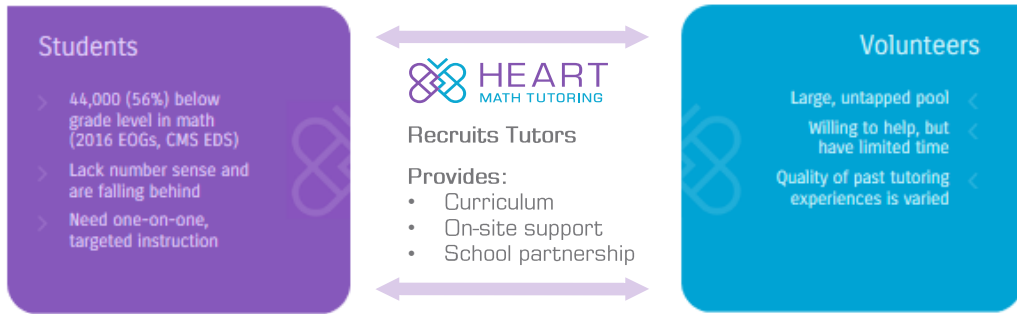


VOLUNTEER WITH HEART

Heart Tutoring connects volunteers with elementary students in high-poverty schools who need one-on-one academic support.



Structure

- > Schools nominate students in grades 1-5 who are below grade level in math for tutoring during the school day.
- > Heart assesses each student to determine individualized gaps and then pairs each student with **weekly tutors** and **targeted lessons**, and **on-site staff support**.

Results

- > **98%** of students to date have **met program growth goals**, set with guidance from elementary math specialists at UNC Charlotte and CMS.
- > **94%** of teachers report **increased student confidence/enthusiasm** toward math.

Building Block Skills Mastered



During 2016/17, Heart students collectively grew from mastering **26%** to **59%** of skills needed, based on grade level standards.

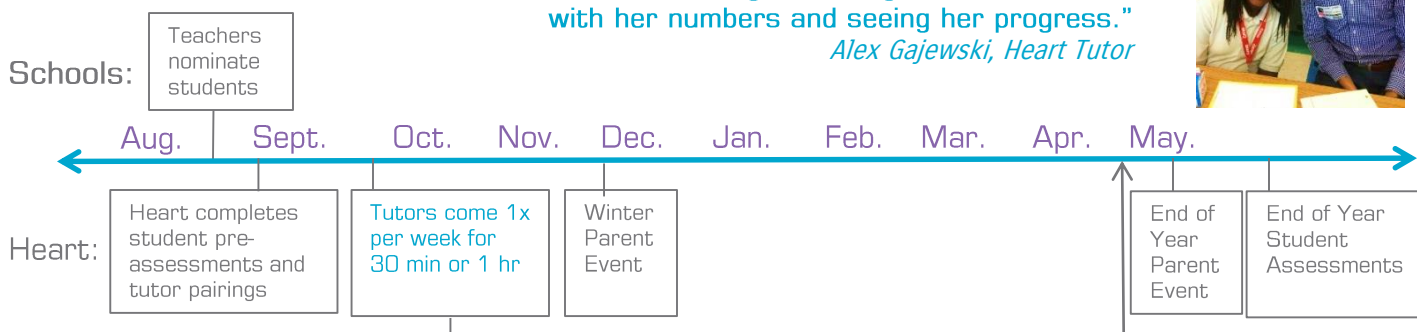
Building block skills include counting, more vs. less, and place value, among others.

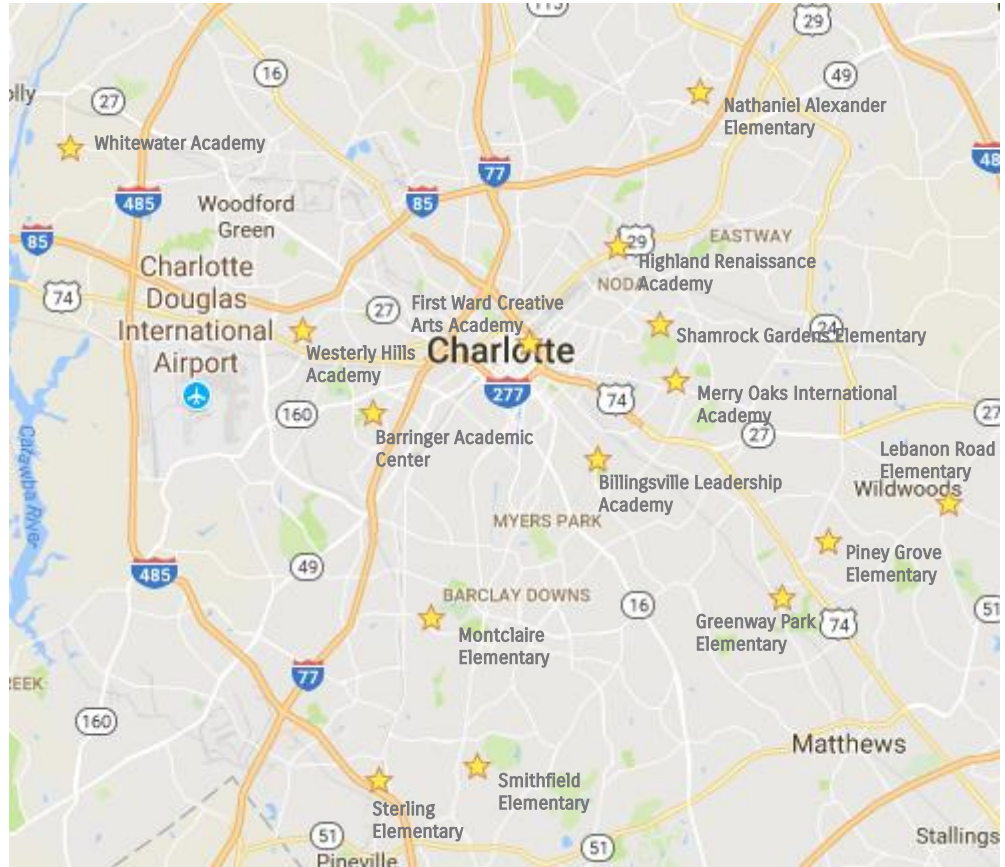
Volunteers
