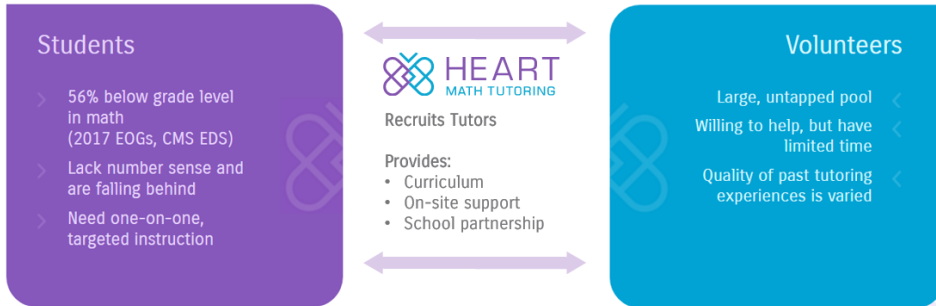


VOLUNTEER WITH HEART

Heart Math Tutoring is the link between volunteers and elementary students who need help.



Structure

- > Schools nominate students in grades 1-5 who are below grade level in math for tutoring during the school day.
- > Heart assesses each student to determine individual gaps and then pairs each student with **weekly tutors**, **targeted lessons**, and **on-site staff support**.

Results

- > **98%** of students to date have **met program growth goals**, set with guidance from elementary math specialists at UNC Charlotte and CMS.
- > **89%** of teachers report **increased student confidence/enthusiasm** toward math.



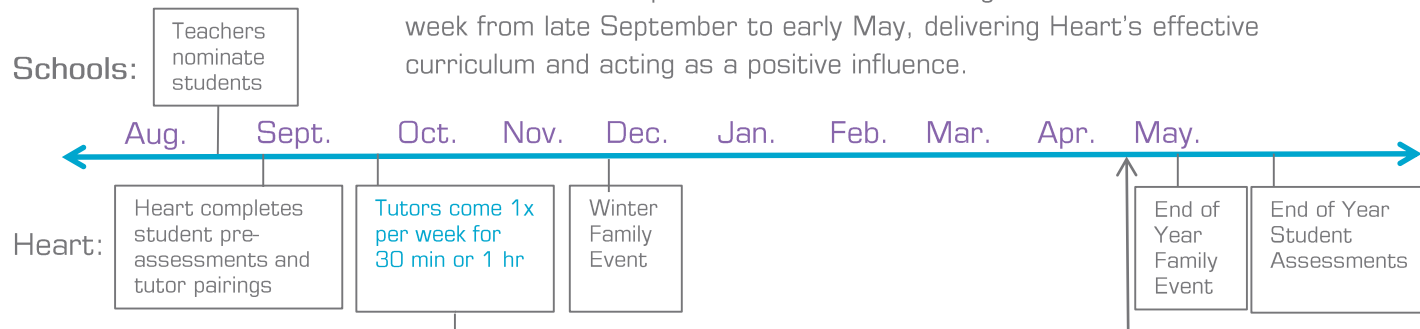

- > Heart volunteers provide one-on-one tutoring for 30 minutes or 1 hour each week from late September to early May, delivering Heart's effective curriculum and acting as a positive influence.
