Did you know more than half of economically disadvantaged students in Charlotte are below grade level in elementary math? Without intervention, students often fall further behind as they move to new grade levels. However, with targeted instruction and one-on-one encouragement from Heart Tutoring volunteers, students can close gaps in basic math skills and build enthusiasm toward academics. **To date, 98% of Heart Tutoring students have met growth goals in math on assessments correlated with NC End of Grade Tests, and 92% of teachers report an increase in student confidence.**
