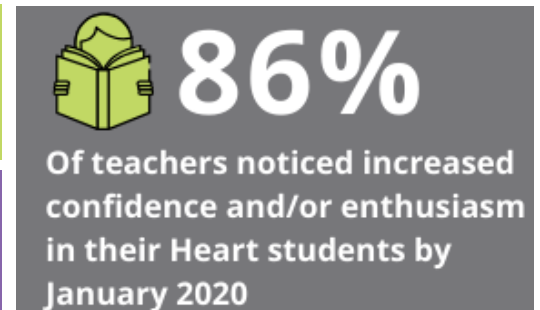
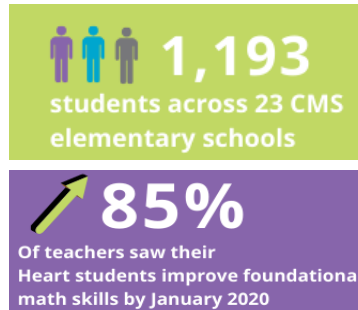
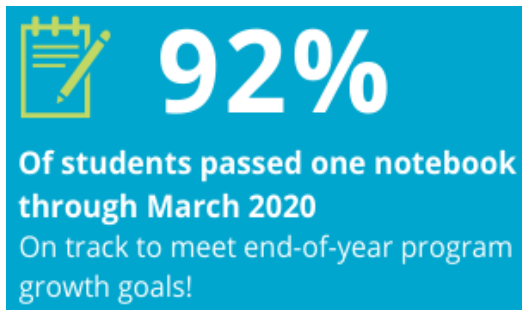
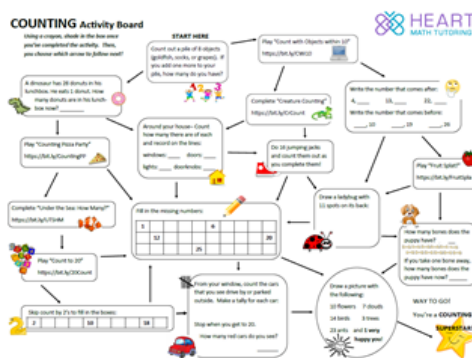


The mission of Heart Math Tutoring is to ensure all elementary students develop the strong foundation in math and enthusiasm for academics needed for long-term success, by helping schools use volunteers as **tutors**. Since 2013, the Charlotte based nonprofit, built from a partnership between Social Venture Partners, Communities In Schools, and Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools, has grown to now recruit and support 1,300 volunteer tutors across 23 Charlotte elementary schools.

Students

Heart has created printable activity boards for families to play at home that are aligned with our curriculum. As an extension of our “End-of-Year Take Home Games” typically shared at Family Events, **we are sending math kits home** with students with dice, cards and games to play at home, along with their certificate of progress and a note from their tutor or coordinator!

Families and School Partners

Heart is sending weekly newsletters to Heart families with community updates and curated math resources, along with individualized e-mails with content based on the notebook in which their student was working. **We continue recording videos of Heart games** that can be accessed on cell phones and played by students and families at home. We shared these resources with all 23 schools and have received positive feedback from principals and teachers!

Heart Tutors

Tutors have written letters, sent photos, and even created short video messages that were shared with their students. **Heart tutors have gone the extra mile** to continue encouraging Heart students!
